#### Who?

FIUs, anti-corruption agencies, police, prosecutors and investigative journalists

#### What for?

Speed up investigations and systematic intelligence-gathering on suspect individuals and organisations

- Omprehensive search of 200+ keywords in several languages
- Custom report function and automatic creation of website screenshots as PDFs

## **Features**



Search for individuals or companies, plus spelling variations



Search 200+ keywords in multiple languages related to financial or other crimes, or upload custom keyword lists



Quickly check linked sources, like Crunchbase, Wikipedia and deep web databases



BOI analyses the text and extracts persons, organisations, positions, locations and keywords



Skim the documents – BOI extracts the main content and highlights your subject and keywords for you



Create a report to print or save as PDF, including any document you select

# How to sign up

We offer packages of 500, 2,000 and 5,000 searches per year.

All public-sector organisations can request 2,000 searches/year for free. Non-profit organisations and small and medium-sized enterprises receive a 50% discount.
